### Approval Processing Fee

Starting on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, we will implement the approval processing fees for all show approvals emailed or mailed in. We have waived this fee for the first half of the year to allow educational opportunities and to ensure you and show management teams familiarize yourselves with our new online system. The

processing fee will be based on the level that your event is, as seen above. These fees were approved by the Board in 2023 and have been listed in the 2024 [Fees Policy](#) since the beginning of the year.

# Amateur Derby

Are you hosting an Amateur Derby class running with your Derby slate at your event? Be sure to check that all exhibitors are eligible by using the eligibility tool on ReinerSuite to avoid any disqualifications and fines for the riders.

Simply select the Amateur class #2800 and select the rider by entering their name or member number and searching for them. It will then tell you if they are eligible and if not, the exact reason why!

### Eligibility Tool

To check eligibility please enter a competition license for a horse and select a class below. It is advised to specify the date if it is in the future. Be sure to specify the region or country you wish to validate in *Eligibility Area*.

*It's the responsibility of owners and riders to know NRHA's eligibility rules and their own earnings. (<https://nrha.com/eligibility>). When eligibility limits are surpassed during the show year, riders can complete the year in that class or division. Please contact the NRHA office if you have any questions on a member's or horse's current eligibility.*
